"Via Dolorosa"

WHAT?

Via Dolorosa ("Way of Grief" in Latin) is a road in the old city of Jerusalem, a path where Jesus was lead in agony, carrying the crucifixion cross. There are a total of 14 stations along this path, based on events that occurred on the way to the Golgotha hill, the site of crucifixion, which is located at the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. This famous walk is reenacted yearly in Jerusalem during Easter weekend. This can also be a powerful weekend for you locally.

The **Via Dolorosa** walk is a **Speed-the-Light** evangelism event that will impact your life! The mission is to carrying crosses on a 35-mile walk over a period of 3 days on Easter weekend. (this can be shortened as needed) This will take place throughout the Appalachian District as we proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ to our communities in order to raise money for missionaries around the world. Each participant will have pledge sheets in order to raise money. Be a part of carrying the cross and making a statement for Jesus Christ in your community!

WHY?

- 1) To be a witness for Jesus Christ
- 2) To see the lives of people changed by the reality of the cross
- 3) Raise money for a great cause, Speed-the Light, and help missionaries around the globe.

HOW TO RAISE THE MONEY?

- 1) Pledge forms are provided. Have individuals pledge either per mile or for a one time amount. (Suggest at least \$10.00, but accept anything.)
- 2) Contact (in person) local businesses using a letter from your youth leader. Include the following in the letter:
 - (a) The donation is tax deductible (they will receive a receipt).
 - (b) The cause—what we are doing and why. (Speed the Light: money for missionaries to buy equipment such as vehicles, sound equipment, etc.)
 - (c) Any business that gives \$100 or more will receive free advertising in the newspaper, on the radio, on a sponsor board, and in your church bulletin.
- 3) TIP: When you go to businesses, ask if they may want to top another business... EX. "This business gave \$100; what would you like to give?"
- 4) Ask parents to take pledge forms to work (get money up-front). *All money is to be collected before the event, if possible!

THE (SUGGESTED) PLAN

Aim to raise at least \$300.00

>That's 3 businesses at \$100.00 each

>30 people at \$10.00 each

>15 people at \$20.00 each

*Many could do much more than this. Please raise as much money as possible, even above and beyond \$300.00. Remember, we're doing this for Jesus to help spread the gospel around the world!

REWARDS:

*Everyone who participates will receive a special momento.

*The top 3 people who raise the most over \$500.00 will receive:

Note: Letters for you to carry to businesses have been included in this packet. You will most likely have a better response by taking the letter "in person" than calling over the phone.

Maintain a Proper Attitude at All Times

"Your attitude should be that of Jesus Christ." Phillippians 2:5

- ♦ Have a positive outlook on learning through this trip.
- Be willing to learn something new about your spiritual life and who you are in Christ.
- Please walk without complaining...this can be difficult.
- Be flexible...you may have to adjust to conditions that you may not enjoy.
- Be an encourager and supporter.
- Remember why you are carrying the cross.
- This event has proved to be powerful in every way. Let's keep it that way!!!

REMEMBER:

This is going to be one of the most incredible things you will ever do as a witness for Jesus Christ. Your best behavior will be required. We will be walking along streets and roads that require you to be alert, courteous, and cautious. If your "goofing around" or attitude hurts the witness of Jesus or the safety of the group, you will be sent home. This is non-negotiable.



Items You Need to Bring

Permission/Insurance Release Form: MUST HAVE! See your youth pastor for this.

Personal Items: Rain gear, camera (optional), 3 changes of clothes, sleeping bag, pillow, bathroom items (towels, wash cloths, soap, etc.), vaseline/lotion for feet, toilet paper (1 roll), plastic bag for dirty clothes, sunglasses, sunscreen, money for snacks and "Via Dolorosa" expense

Clothing: T-shirts, jacket, sweat shirts, lightweight pants/sweats (jeans are NOT suggested—you will be in pain!), comfortable shorts (decent/modest), 2 pairs of tennis shoes/walking shoes.

Suggested medical supplies:

Band-aids, gauze pads and wraps, ace bandages, ice packs, sports cream (for sore muscles), blister kit.
