- 1. Groups will not be accepted without proper adult supervision. We strongly recommend that you bring one adult for every 4 or 5 young people.
- 2. NO fireworks, tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, drugs, knives, weapons of any kind, or profanity will be allowed at any time. Immediate expulsion if violated.
- 3. The Fine Arts / AYM staff and security reserve the right to inspect the contents of all personal belongings and to withhold and/or dispose of any improper or illegal contents. The participation of each attendee at the Fine Arts Festival indicates their acknowledgment of this right.
- 4. Appalachian Youth Ministries will not be responsible for the whereabouts, conduct, or safety of your group or their possessions. That responsibility belongs to group leaders.
- 5. ALL staff members are authorized to maintain order.
- 6. NO "public displays of affection" (PDA)!
- 7. Each individual is expected to maintain exemplary Christian behavior, including respect for all property, and leadership (AYM/Fine Arts staff, church, etc.). Violation of this agreement will result in the individual or entire group being sent home at their own expense and the senior pastor receiving a phone call (regardless of the time of day or night).
- 8. Cell phones must be turned off or put on silent during presentations and services.
